FOOD FOR THOUGHT: PURPOSE OF A CREATED THING IS HIDDEN IN THE MIND OF THE CREATOR.

The Bible tells us in Proverbs 19:21, "Many are the plans in the mind of a man, but it is the purpose of the LORD that will stand."

BRISBANE AND PERTH MINISTRY UPDATE (2nd July—31st Aug '14)

IN BRISBANE CITY

I thank God for the opportunity to share the goodness and grace of God abroad and amongst the body of Christ.

My first sermon overseas was on the night of July 2nd 2014, before Australians, PNG residents and PNG World Mission team at Brisbane city. Many have responded positively to His Word. To God be all praises and glory!

The sermon was based on [1 Corinthians 12](#).

Many Members of One Body with Diversity of Functions.

1. There is one Spirit who endows and empowers every believers with varieties of gifts and apportionments to each one individually as He wills.
2. The manifestation of these gifts are for the common good of the Body.
3. Believers were all baptized in one Spirit into one body and all were made to drink of one Spirit.
4. God arranged the members in the body, each of them, as He chose.
5. God honors every members of the body and requires **unity** in the manifestation of the gifts.
6. If one part of the body suffers, every part suffers with it. If one part of the body is praised, every part rejoices with it.

Summary

- Unity in the body of Christ is prerequisite for the growth and expansion of the Church.
- Every believer has a vital role to play in the body of Christ with the enabling power and gifting of the Holy Spirit.

In the next few days I took a team of intercessors (Old mothers) and we did prayer walk in the city square. We had spiritual encounters and had opportunity to share God's love with others on the main streets of the city.

We visited and prayed with individuals, families and friends and moved onto Perth, WA.

IN PERTH, WA.

Ministry in the City.

Challenges: It was very challenging for me personally when I was asked to distribute

gospel tracts in the city square. It was very encouraging the moment I stood there began distributing, my heart sank deeply for lost souls as I confronted different kinds of people. I stood there broke into tears. I didn't care whoever I approached and make sure I tell every person that passed me by that they need Jesus. Never used to this in my country but I thanked God for using me to minister His word to people.

There were number of times atheists, I perceived, would come and spit and squish the tract in front of me telling that they don't need this. There was a very old white fellow in his eighties get right in front of me and sworn to my face as I approached him with tract and the love of Christ.

We were out in the desert for almost a month. I was startled when we were asked by the Indigenous Australians to make garden in the desert. Maybe because Papua New Guinean's were known for gardening. I started out two plots planting Broccolis, Silver bids and Spring Onion with two bags of organic soil, believing in my heart that God can turn such situations to touch and change lives.

Main Ministry Highlights:

- Praying and anointing strategic places of satanic worshipers and witchcraft practices, brothels and pubs.
- Praying and sharing the gospel with sick and homeless people.
- Visiting and praying over ancestral and spiritual sites of Indigenous Australians.



- Visiting and praying over existing run-down churches and praying over and anointing every townships that the Spirit of God will move that hearts of people again.
