Eden Mission School Visit and Meeting – 14-18 January 2016.



It took us a day to make a special trip to Nsong community to meet with leaders and teachers and executive secretary of their association to discuss about handing

over their rundown mission school with its hostels to Nancy and I to manage starting next year

onward. Nsong is a ministry area of Nancy and her potential has been seen and has been entrusted with the school.

Nsong mission school provides education for eight different villages surrounding Nsong village. Each year 200-300 students coming from

poor and broken Hindu, and Christian family background far away to live at the hostel and study there. Most students cannot afford school fees of Rs1000 equivalent to AU\$3-4 charged per month. Seeing the need the India government is likely to introduce free education and introducing Hindu philosophy in order to influence students into Hindu religion, which has been happening in many parts of India. Church leaders and community of believers there could not allow this to happen.

Since the school has been missed manage by unqualified personnel. Therefore, they agreed and entrusted the total management of school to Nancy and I after a lengthy meeting discussing every options. The school will be officially handed over to us in 2017. They only desire effective running and management of the school so that students may not be deceived into attaining free education only to be influenced by Hindu religion with its philosophy. Nancy and I are prayerfully seeking direction from the LORD as we are planning the future of the school.

Meeting with Miss Wirriangsui at Jalukie (Nagaland) - 16 Jan 2016.



On our way to Nsong we have a night with loving family of Miss Wiriangsui, fulltime serving missionary friend and sister with visionary heart for God's mission. We had a time of meal fellowship and prayer. Our meeting with Wiriangsui has birthed "Bridge of Hope Home" (BOHH), which has been conceived and embraced and envisioned in Wiriangsui's heart for many years. BOHH is a hostel which will be established close to four government secondary schools to accommodate students from Hindu, Muslim, Buddhism, Christian faith and other faith who have come from very remote villages and towns seeking free

education and have no proper accommodation. BOHH will provide decent accommodation at low cost to these students. BOHH aims to bridge gap of home and school to equip every child to be holistically developed and well educated. BOHH will be a home away from home where hostellers receive a highest level of care from a dedicated and committed team of Christian staff.

We have drafted BOHH's Aims and Objectives and Wiriangsui will be working toward registering BOHH's while we are away. She agreed to avail her home to start with less than five students. As soon as Nancy and I return from PNG we will be working together with her.

Wirriangsui and her father took us out early morning to show us a piece of land which they have kept it for long time for God's mission purposes and they agreed that BOHH can utilize this piece of land. We have prayed and committed BOHH and its future to the Lord.

Pray and Encourage Students to Prepare for National Exam.

We were invited to encourage and prayer over high school students to prepare them for their final exams. We were honored and joyfully sharing and encouraging from God's Word with Grade 10s of Yachem Secondary school. We all had a powerful time of prayer together, which excited the deputy principal of the school. Together we gave thanks and praise to God for His favor upon the students.
