17th August 2016: The stuff and students of Yawe Moses Secondary School in Simbu Province have invited us to speak during the commissioning of grades ten and twelve students. We thank God that we were honored to stand before a thousand plus students with their teachers and pastors and church leaders of the surrounding communities. Number of students approached us after our presentations and showed their interest to serve in God's mission so we encouraged them and prayed with them. Highlights of Ministry in INDIA



EDEN SCHOOL, NSONG, NAGALAND INDIA.

Nancy and I have been given full responsibility to manage the full running of this school beginning 2017 onward. Eden school is a rundown institution established and managed by Zeme Baptist Association. Because of Nancy's frequent visits and commitment to the school the leaders of the association have invited her to take over the management of the school. Upon their earnest


request earlier this year 2016 we have met with the association leaders and have signed a memorandum of understanding. The school will be officially declared and handed over to me and Nancy by end of 2016. We will fully run the whole affairs of the school with the two hostels attached. The leaders of the association have expressed their great concern that they wanted the school to be well managed and fully and progressively developed. Due to lack of qualified staff and administrators the school and hostels have been poorly managed. There is not much infrastructural, academic, and staff development done. There is a great fear of losing good number of students to government/public schools to be influenced by Hindu philosophy.

Nancy is currently in India doing preparations. Due to dormitories (hostels) not conducive to living many children

from faraway could not make it to school. Eden school mess hall looks very old and has no proper cooking and eating utensils and benches to sit and dine. There is no toilet and shower place.







There are many areas need to be improved in order to attract more students from far villages otherwise most students will be attracted to Hindu school where there is tuition free policy. The only way to retain students at Eden school is to improve the learning facilities, engage qualified teachers, and charge affordable tuition and admission fees. These will be our challenges and we are encouraged and positive about it for we are able to do all things through Christ who strengthens us.
