English Teaching Ministry Opportunity in Thailand

Mondos were relocated from The Bible League Foundation to their new ministry site; Hang Dong District Chiangmai province, Thailand. They were invited by the Tetchaban Hang Dong school administration to



teach English as a volunteer. The school has arranged the accommodation for the missionary family and is taking care of the house bills. Tetchaban School is a public Buddhist school and is administered according to the principles and standards of Buddhism. Every morning the students assemble and pray to Buddha. Every midday after lunch, all the students are assembled for twenty minutes of meditation practice. None of the eighteen local teachers are Christians teaching a thousand plus students in the school. Paul is teaching listening and

speaking English to all classes, one hour for each class per week. Paul is teaching English eighteen hours each week at the school.



A young Buddhist music teacher, **Kajhonekeat**, who was interested to learn English so Paul is teaching him free conversation English for two hours every Saturday at the missionaries' home. Nancy and Paul are hosting him every Saturday at their home and praying and believeing that he will find Lord Jesus, as they continue to share His love with Kajhonekeat. Pray for him that he may be willing and open to listen to the Good News of the Lord Jesus.

Paul is also teaching four hours free conversation English at the church for four hours each week. Our Sunday school teachers and elders of the church are interested and are committing their time to learn English. The free conversation English class is open to anyone who is interested to learn to practice speaking. This is one of the way to reach out to the students and young people who are seeking to learn and improve in their English skills. We are praying and believing that more missionaries from PNG will come as volunteers to teach English in Thailand to share the love of Christ.

Missionaries' house has bigger living room and Paul and Nancy have decided and prayerfully making

plans to start up the after school and weekend English club at their home, and they are awaiting the sense of direction and confirmation from the Lord. In the meantime they open up their home to host children



evangelism meetings by churches and Christian organization in Chiangmai. The first children and youth evangelism team from Korea through Vision Church in Chiangmai were using their house and minister to children and adults in the colony where Paul and Nancy are residing.

Visas and Passports

Paul and Nancy's visas were granted for number of times without much complications and delays. We are acknowledging and grateful to God for the hardworking Bible League staff with their expertise, continued to help for their visas. Both missionaries were granted one year volunteer visas. God has answered the prayers. Baby Nimbine Lemshong Mondo was successfully granted her PNG passport. The LORD has used Rodney, a committed Christian brother together with the PNGSHM team in Port Moresby have been working together to get the Passport done for little Nimbine. This gives us hope that Nimbine will be able to travel to either country of her grandparents in the future.
